Dear Christ Church Music Camp Participant,

Greetings in the Name of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ! We thank God for the opportunity to teach your children this summer. It is our pleasure to offer this camp as a means of educating students in the beauty of music and in singing with both joy and skill. We pray that your entire family will be blessed through your children's immersion in the study and singing of Scripture and music on the theme *T*.

Following is information you will want to read immediately *and* retain for reference regarding the week of camp. Please feel free to contact us if you have any questions.

REGISTRATION for all camps (**Prep**, **Junior**, and **Senior**) will begin at **8:30am and be open until 9:00 on Monday, July 18** in the Fellowship Hall of the Nazarene Church (1400 E 7th St, Moscow, Idaho).

- Bring your *emergency release form* (one per student) and your *picnic permission slip* (one per family).
- Once registered, students will receive their music, binder, and materials for the week.
- Students in **Junior & Senior** Camps will then have a *voice hearing* so they may be placed in the appropriate section of the choir.
- If a student wishes to *audition for the Friday recital* (details below), they may sign up for an audition time at registration.

WHAT TO BRING EACH DAY

- **All students** should bring a *water bottle* (marked with the student's name!) and a *pencil*.
- Students in **Junior & Senior** Camps also need to bring a *cold lunch* (no microwave available) and a *Bible* (marked with the student's name).

as well as the Saturday rehearsal and concert.

- Please have students to their classrooms *on time* each morning.
- Note that the Friday schedule differs from Monday-Thursday. On Friday, **Prep Campers** need to bring their picnic lunch, and they will stay into the afternoon (until 4pm).
- Also on Friday, *parents & families of all three camps* are invited to join us at **10:00am in the sanctuary** at the Nazarene Church for a recital of students, faculty, and guest artists; at approximately **noon for a picnic at Lions Park (Latah County Fairgrounds)**; and at **3:00pm in the fellowship hall** at the Nazarene Church for a ball where the campers will be presenting their dances from the week for one another.

DAILY DRESS CODE

Generally we defer to the wisdom of the parents. Two items that we would request are first, that students wear comfortable closed-toe shoes (i.e. no sandals, flip-flops, etc.), well suited for their dance class as well as any games they may play during the lunch break, and second, that students not wear hats. Beyond that we suggest the principle of loving your neighbor be applied: dress more for the comfort of others (i.e. modestly, respectfully) than one's own.

FRIDAY RECITAL

Friday's recital is an opportunity for a few students who perform at an *intermediate* or *advanced* level on voice or an instrument to share music in a recital alongside faculty and guest artists. The recital occurs during class time (at 10:05am) and parents and families of all campers are invited to attend. Interested students may audition during the registration time (or later that day), and should come to camp with something prepared. SATURDAY CONCERT

Invite your friends and family! This is the grand finale of our week of music making and is our opportunity to share our music with you. There will also be a reception immediately following the concert for campers, family, friends, and guests.

- Concert is at **3:00pm** in the sanctuary of the Moscow Church of the Nazarene (1400 East 7th Street, on the corner of Mountain View, between 6th and 7th).
- **Call time for Campers is 1:00 noon** and they should come *in concert dress* prepared to stay through the duration of the concert.
- A **snack** will be provided for the campers in between the dress rehearsal and the concert.
- **Concert Dress**
 - Girls--skirt, below the knee, please.
 - Boys--khaki pants, with belt, dress socks, and shoes.
 - All--Camp t-shirts!
