## FOOT WASHING AS HUMBLE SERVICE:

- Disciples argue about who is the greatest.

*o Luke 22:24-27*

- What does greatness look like?

- Greatness looks like weakness.

*o 1 Corinthians 1:26-28*

- Christ knew who He was. Do we know who we are?

*o Ephesians 3:14-19*

## FOOT WASHING AS CLEANSING FROM SIN:

- Jesus' special interaction with Peter is very different from the surrounding passage.

- Jesus is picturing for the disciples the work He is about to do on the cross.

- Jesus is demonstrating what the incarnation is all about.

*o Phil 2:6-7*

- This is what forgiveness looks like.
